Concrete and Masonry - Citations

OSHA has several different types of citations. The most common in the concrete and masonry for 2013 are the following.

#3 Scaffolding, #2 HAZCOM, #1 Fall Protection

- Scaffolding needs to be erected properly with oversight of, and "green tagged" by a competent person.
- All sub-contractors are required to provide ARCO with their MSDS/SDS sheets and HAZCOM plan before work.
- Take fall protection seriously! 100% over six feet at ALL ARCO jobs!

OSHA Citations Types

- Other Than Serious: Issued when several injury or death was not likely. Proposed fine can be up to \$7,000 for each offense.
- Serious: When there was a substantial probability of death or serious injury, and the employer knew and should have known.
 Mandatory fine of \$7,000 for each offense.
- Willful: When employer shows plane indifference to law and he/she knows what they are doing is in violation. Initial fine is \$5,000 - \$70,000. Individuals can see up to \$250,000 if there is a court conviction.
- Repeat of any violation is up to \$70,000 each!
